My current workflow is developing HTML apps using:

- Coffeescript (compiled into JS)
- Stylus (compiled into CSS)
- Jade (compiled into HTML)

When it's possible, I like to develop the website with seamless navigation (with no browser refresh).

I do this by rendering all the single pages from the backend (php or nodejs) and eventually by ajax I grab the html of the other pages where the user is browsing to, after the first page. So I manage the create/destroy process of each javascript view in a transparent and dynamic way.

By doing this the website gets a good SEO indexing (every single page is rendered by the backend) and the user gets a great user experience (having a seamless navigation).

### **Mobile App Development**

I developed two Android native apps in Java using Eclipse.

Since a while I'm studying the development of HTML Apps using wrappers such as MeteorJS, Phonegap, etc..
